Charlie Brown Memorial Basketball Classic Tournament Information

1. The Tournament will be double elimination.
2. Team rosters will be limited to a minimum of 8 players and a maximum of 15.
3. All team players must have identical shirts and all shirts must be numbered. Teams should have home and away shirts with them at all times.
4. Games for grades 3rd/4th will consist of four 6-minute quarters, all other divisions will be 7 minute quarters.
5. All officials will be provided through the tournament director.
6. Each team will be responsible for their own valuables. Locker Rooms are not available for use.
7. **Each team will be responsible for providing a scorekeeper for each game. Score sheets will be available for you to use.**
8. Those teams finishing in the top two positions will be presented team trophies at the awards presentation at the conclusion of their final game.
9. **The coach of the team is responsible for the proper conduct of his players, other coaches, team members and fans associated with the team as well as his own behavior while participating in the tournament. If proper behavior is not exhibited by those people associated with said team, it could result in forfeiture and expulsion from the tournament at that time and in future years.**
10. Admission fee per day for spectators will be \$2.00 per person/\$1.00 for students.
11. 3rd and 4th grades, 5th and 6th grade ONLY – no full court press until the last 2 minutes of the 2nd and 4th quarters. No press rule for 7th and 8th grade.
12. Each team will receive two full time outs and 2 thirty sec. time outs per game.
13. All levels – NO FULL COURT PRESS allowed if you are a team that has a 15 point (or more) spread over your opponent.
14. Absolutely **NO jewelry** will be allowed **for any reason** during play.
15. Absolutely **NO hard casts** will be allowed to be worn during play.



DIRECTIONS TO YORK MIDDLE SCHOOL

30 Organug Road, York, ME 03909

From I-95: take the York Exit (Exit 7), bear right at the lights onto Route 1. Travel to the top of the hill and take a left at the lights onto York Street/Route 1A. Just down York Street on your right you will see the York Street Baptist Church. The church sits on the corner of York Street and Organug Road. Take a right onto Organug Road. Travel about 1/8 of a mile on Organug Road and York Middle School is located on your left.

DIRECTIONS TO YORK HIGH SCHOOL

1 Robert Stevens Drive • York, Maine 03909

From I-95: take the York Exit (Exit 7), bear right at the lights onto Route 1. Travel to the top of a hill and take a left at the lights onto Route 1A. Travel one mile to the monument and bear left. Travel six-tenths of a mile and turn right onto Long Sands Road. York High School is seven-tenths of a mile on the left.
