To Parents and Skiers:

Welcome to the upcoming trips to Shawnee Peak. We are all looking forward to a lot of fun and great skiing. In order to insure hassle free trips, we'd like to go over a few things. Please read carefully and ask any questions that you may have.

The schedule of after school trips is as follows:

Friday, January 15th, Friday, January 22nd, Friday, January 29th, Wednesday, February 3rd (early release day), Friday, February 5th, Friday, February 12th, and Friday, February 19th. Payment in full and all required release and rental forms are due in the office no later than the Monday before each ski trip. These trips are reserved on a first come, first serve basis, so don't hesitate. Refunds will only be given up until the day before the scheduled ski trip. No exceptions. *****If a trip is cancelled we will do our best to make it up, however, please remember you must re-register for the trip. We will not automatically transfer your registration***.**

Skis and all related equipment can be dropped off at the Middle School and High School before school between 7:30 and 7:45am. Please use the front gym doors at the Middle School and the front office at the High School.

The bus will leave from the York Middle School and High School at 2:15 pm. Please be on time. **EARLY RELEASE: Leave School 11:15 am and RETURN between 7:15 & 7:30 pm.**

Upon arrival at the mountain, group leaders will go to the office to pick up the tickets, while an ambassador welcomes the group. Please stay with the bus until the group leader has returned with the tickets.

If you need rental equipment, please fill out the form in advance at the parks and recreation office. Pre-registration for rental equipment should make this process faster and more efficient. This form is also available at our website www.yorkmaine.org.

All participants should meet back at the bus by 9:00 pm. Please, do not take the last trip at 8:59 pm to the top of the furthest peak. Should you decide to do this, chances are, you will arrive back to a very tired, impatient group of people.

We should arrive back at the Schools between 10:45 and 11:00 pm. **Please be aware that it's been a wonderful, yet long day for all. Please be on time picking up your skier.**

Last but not least: **Please, ski under control and with care.** Chaperones number 1 to every 10 skiers; however, we are unable to follow you around the mountain. Display pagers are given to every group leader to insure quick communication with the ski patrol and base facilities, should the need arise.
